NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Works to the church tower clock comprising:

1. Installation of automatic winding comprising removal of existing weight lines, pulleys and weights and their retention in the clock room, clamping of a small steel frame onto the clock and installation of a hardwood seat board onto the steel frame, installation of two automatic winding units to the hardwood seat board, installation of sprockets to the main barrels and installation of pulleys, weight lines and weights appropriate for the new configuration
2. Dismantling and removing the clock movement to the workshop and cleaning, de-greasing and polishing of parts and bushing two brass bearings, and then returning and re-building the clock on site
3. Installation of automatic regulation comprising installation of a bracket at the back of the clock for the regulator, installation of control unit and wiring into 240V mains supply
4. Installation of 240V sockets as required for the two automatic winding units and the automatic regulator

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
